On the Tuesday before Thanksgiving, these organizations meet to pick up their turkeys for delivery to the assigned families. It runs like clockwork and within 3 hours all the turkeys are delivered. In 2016, over 84 local organizations received more than 6,200 turkeys which fed more than 50,000 people in our region.
